CLUBHOUSE CHANGING ROOM POLICY FOR MEMBERS AND U18S

At Barnsgrove, we provide a safe, respectful, and comfortable environment for all members. To ensure an enjoyable experience for everyone using the clubhouse facilities, we ask that you adhere to the following guidelines for the changing rooms:

1. General Guidelines for All Members

- Changing rooms are for the exclusive use of Barnsgrove members and their guests.
- Members must always respect the privacy and comfort of others while using the changing rooms.
- Mobile phones and cameras are strictly prohibited in the changing rooms to ensure privacy for all users.
- Any inappropriate behaviour, including harassment or misconduct, will not be tolerated and may result in suspension or termination of membership.
- Please leave the changing room in a tidy condition after use. Dispose of any personal items and litter in the appropriate bins.
- Personal lockers are available for securing belongings. Valuables left in the changing room are left at the owner's risk. The management accepts no liability for loss, theft, or damage.

2. Policy for Visitors Under 18 (U18)

- Visitors under the age of 18 must adhere to the same changing room guidelines as adults.
- U18 visitors are expected to respect the privacy of others and avoid any inappropriate behaviour in the changing room.
- Mobile phones and cameras are not permitted in the changing rooms, including for U18 visitors.

3. Compliance with Barnsgrove Staff

- All members are required to follow the instructions of Barnsgrove staff regarding the use of changing room facilities.
- Any concerns or complaints regarding the changing rooms should be reported promptly to a staff member or management.
